British Council in Azerbaijan launches a competition for exclusive and free **IELTS Progress Check official online practice tests**. 10 selected winners of the competition will each receive a free individual [IELTS Progress Check](#) online test coupon.

To benefit from this offer, test takers are required to:

- Complete the [online form](#) placed on the British Council website, and answer the following **competition question** included in the form:
 - **“Please describe how your IELTS test will change your life for the better.”**
- Make an IELTS test purchase from the British Council between **1 December 2021** and **21 January 2022** for any IELTS test sessions available until **31 March 2022**.

Winners of the competition will be notified on **26 January 2022** by the British Council office in Azerbaijan. The selection process will be undertaken by the British Council IELTS test centre team in Azerbaijan. The participants who have submitted the most creative responses to the **competition question** above will be selected.

IELTS Progress Check is an official IELTS online practice test. Completed tests are marked by IELTS trained and qualified markers. Test takers receive an official feedback report, including an indicative overall test band score as well as a band score for each section of the test (Reading, Listening, Writing & Speaking). The report is ready within five days of completing the IELTS Progress Check practice test.

The cost of a single IELTS Progress Check online practice test is 49.95 USD. 10 winners of the competition will receive access to IELTS Progress Check for free.

1. The offer is available only for the test takers who will take an IELTS or UKVI test at the official British Council IELTS test centre in Azerbaijan.
 2. The IELTS Progress Check can be used by an individual user. Agents, test centres or any other institutional body are not eligible to participate in this competition.
 3. The test takers have to purchase an IELTS test between **1 December 2021** and **21 January 2022**. The test can be booked for any available session on the British Council online registration system until **31 March 2022**.
 4. The IELTS tests are not refundable once purchased for this campaign.
 5. The promotion is limited in number and the prizes will be offered based on the results of the competition question in the [online form](#) placed on the British Council website.
 6. British Council reserves every right to stop the campaign at any time.
 7. Individuals under 18, the British Council staff and their first-degree relatives are not allowed to participate in the campaign.
